## Financial Report

# 7. Reading Room

Matthew Elias has agree to donate £150 at the beginning of the financial year towards the cost of electricity and insurance to help ensure the Reading Room is retained for community use.

This year the cost of insurance was initially £176.13, with a supplement of £87 for the building and contents Sept 2019-May2020 (total £263.71). Next year the total cost will be c. £280.

We have already received £80 from ESBC for the December election, and there will be the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner election in May.

#### 8. Environment

<u>Tree Planting</u>: the trees from the Woodland Trust look likely to arrive in November rather than this month.

<u>Community Gang</u>: it was decided that this would be dedicated to maintenance of the Reading Room and its garden. Ideas will be exchanged via email.
